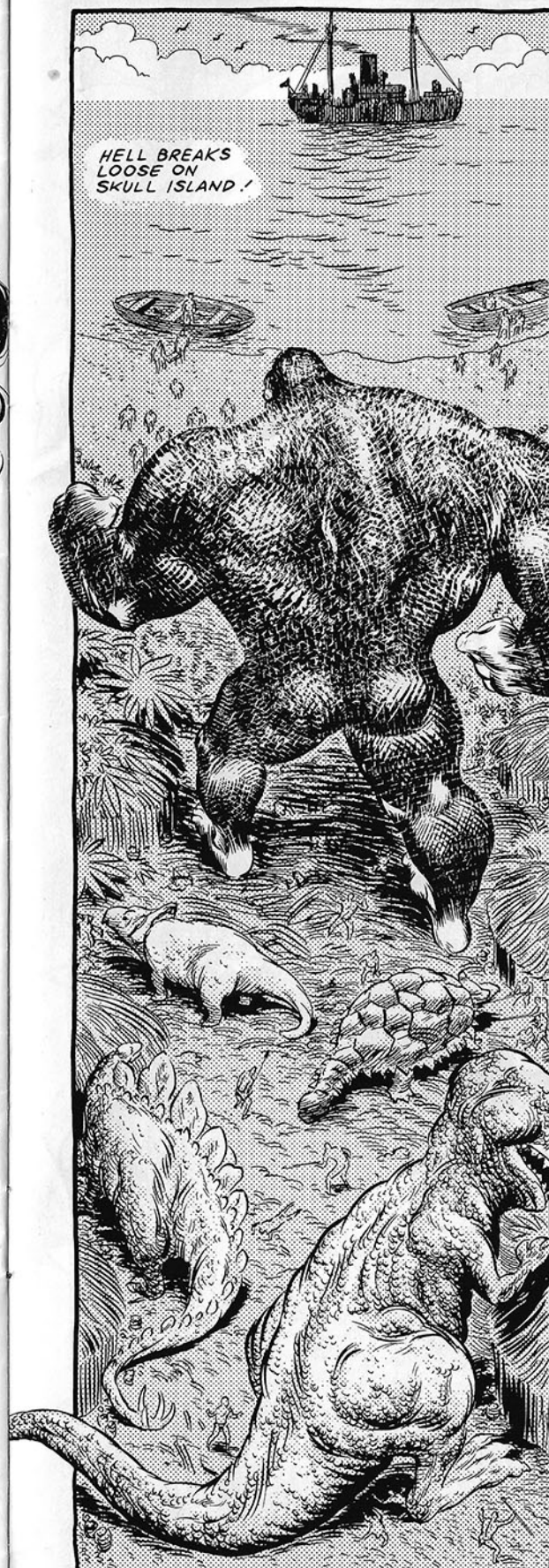


THE THRESHOLD THROWN OPEN, JACK APPEARS, BEARING ANN, NOW COLLAPSED FROM FATIGUE!

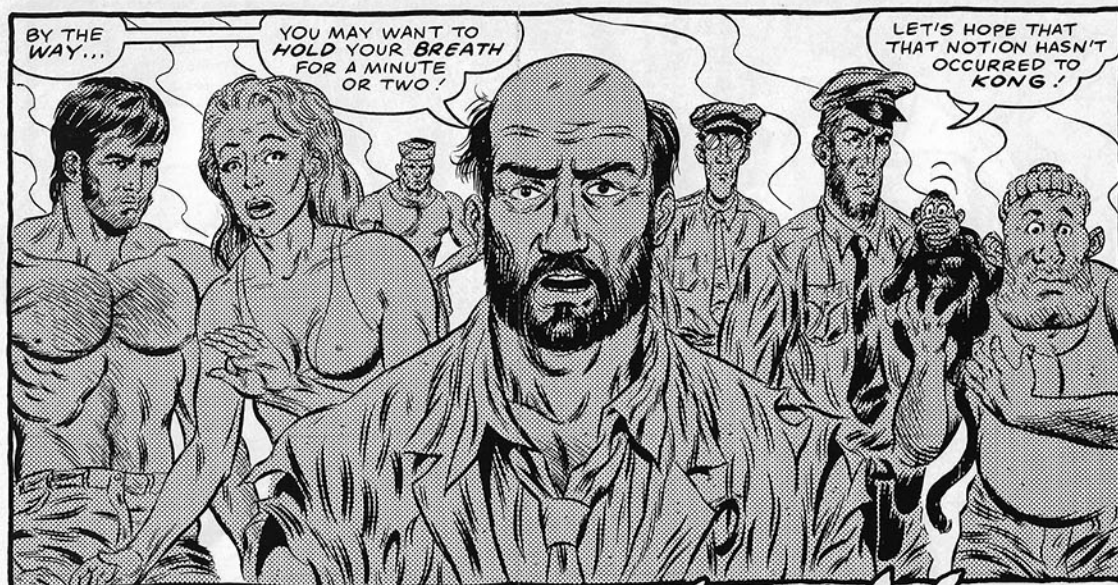
